NOTES REGARDING APPLICATION

MEMBERSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

A. Payment of subscriptions

1. Subscriptions are payable on 1 January each year for the whole of the calendar year (ie until 31st December), whatever the section. No refunds are provided for resignation during the year.
2. You may choose to pay your subscriptions by either one full payment on or around the 1st January, or if you prefer, spread the payments monthly over the course of the year. If you choose to spread your payments monthly an additional charge of 7% pa of your annual subscription will be added to cover bank charges and administration fees. **PLEASE NOTE THAT THE MONTHLY OPTION IS A DEFERRED PAYMENT SCHEME AND THAT ALL INSTALLMENTS UNDER THE SCHEME ARE REQUIRED TO CLEAR YOUR DEBT.**
3. The Direct Debit Scheme is a continuing agreement for the payment of annual subscriptions as detailed in your annual subscriptions breakdown which is sent to you before the new subscription year begins. Membership will automatically be renewed on 1st January each year unless prior notice of cancellation of membership has been received by 20th December of the proceeding year. The facility to pay annual fees by Direct Debit is based upon a contractual obligation to make all monthly payments as detailed on the annual subscription breakdown. Whilst under The Direct Debit Guarantee you may cancel a Direct Debit at any time, you will still be liable for the remaining outstanding instalments.
4. If the member:
 - (a) fails to comply with any of the terms of their Direct Debit agreement; or
 - (b) fails to pay Alderley Edge Cricket Club a monthly payment within 7 days of the due date for payment ; or
 - (c) fails to maintain a Direct Debit mandate;then and in any such event the member's membership (inclusive of family/related members membership for which the member is responsible under the Direct Debit) will be suspended with effect from the date on which the event of default has occurred.
5. Following an event of default as described in clause A4 the member shall pay to Alderley Edge Cricket Club all unpaid fees in respect of the remainder of such membership year.
6. This agreement is personal to the member and is not assignable by the member.

B. Membership card

1. Once your Direct Debit instruction has been processed you will be issued with a membership card which entitles you to discounted Bar and Food purchases at the Clubhouse upon presentation of the card to the Club's bar staff.
2. The membership card will continue each year unless you do not renew your subscription or you fail to make payment of your subscription by January 31st or you cancel your Direct Debit at any time.

C. Club Rules

1. By applying for membership, you agree to be bound by the Rules of Alderley Edge Cricket Club.

D. Membership categories - the subscription rates and categories are set each year by the General Committee and published with the annual renewal notices. We draw your attention to the following additional notes:

1. Cricket and Hockey: You will note that there is a separate subscription structure for hockey players and cricketers playing one or two games. Please note that the discount given to these categories may be balanced by a match fee payable per game.
2. For Under 19 Tennis and Squash applications, a parent or guardian must be a current member. It may therefore be necessary for a parent to also submit an application. In such cases, if he or she is a non player, the Social category is suggested. This is not necessary for Cricket and Hockey applications which are "team sports". However, the Committee hope that all parents of junior members join the club and use the facilities of the club.
3. Under 30 subscriptions relate to ages on 1 January in the year of application.
4. Country Membership is a special facility only available where a member permanently resides over 50 miles from the Club for a full Club year.
5. The tennis renewal premium is a charge on tennis section members in order to create a fund to allow for the renewal of the artificial surfaces when they become due.
6. A separate application is required for each member. Under 19 members should complete the Junior Membership Application Form incorporating child welfare details.
